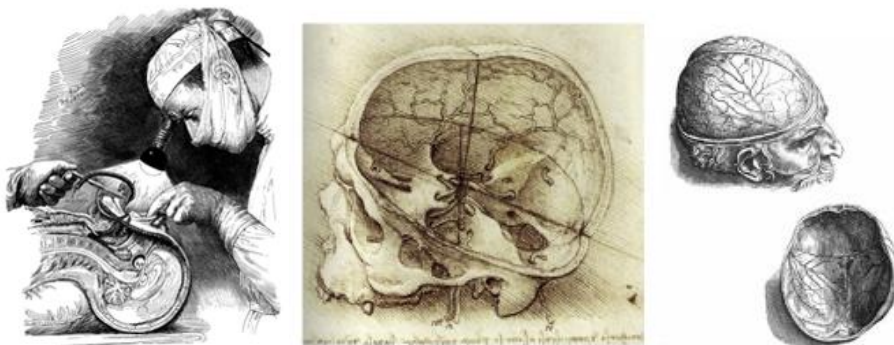

Pituitary Surgery and the “Combined Eye” of Surgeon and Artist



The trans-sphenoidal approach to the pituitary gland and sella turcica was pioneered over a century ago. The story of the development and near extinction of this technique is the story of the founding fathers of neurosurgery and their apprentices. This master-apprentice relationship was also mirrored in the artists who documented their work.
