The youngest son of Charles Nicholson Macintosh, newspaper editor and mayor of Timaru in 1901, and his wife, Lydia Beatrice Thompson, he became the first professor of anaesthetics outside the United States. Part 2 will deal with his career after the end of the Great War, his successful practice in London, his appointment to the Nuffield Chair of Anaesthesia in 1937, and his later career.
